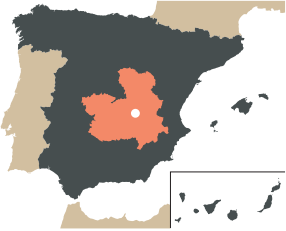


Punctum – Intrépido



COUNTRY: Spain

800m altitude above sea

USDA – Wine made with organic grapes

Punctum Intrépido is a very accessible biodynamic red wine, with all the benefits of organic and biodynamic farming: authentic and beautiful aromas, delicacy on the palate, free of any chemicals, herbicides or animal products.

Background:

Produced by winemaker Ruth Fernández, Punctum “Intrépido” (Intrepid) is a low sulfite content wine, made from proprietary blend of organic red grapes, grown on mixed soil of sand and clay.

In the province of Cuenca near central Spain, our vineyard is located in an area where wine culture has been around for decades. It sits in an altitude of 800 meters above sea level. The continental mediterranean climate of this territory brings plenty of sunlight to the vineyard, and the clay soil retains water, essential for the health of the vines.



Tasting notes:

Beautiful cherry red color with a purple undertone. The nose shows off bright red berry notes. Smooth and harmonious finish.

Red blend.
Organic vines planted in 2005.

Vinification

By winemaker Ruth Fernández. Clarified with Bentonite. Physical filtration. Cold stabilization. No animal product used.

No GMO Yeast Used.
Less than 100ppm Sulfites.
