Galerna is the wind that runs through the North coast of Spain. Like blooming flowers this wind usually arrives in in the spring. Just like the Galerna, this fresh and fruity wine will sweep you off your feet!

### **Background:**

The verdejo Grape is almost exclusive to Spain, a perfect choice for those looking for something uniquely Spanish. This Galerna shows the bright and fresh flavors of the Verdejo, and it's also certified organic.

In the province of Cuenca near central Spain, our vineyard is located in an area where wine culture has been around for decades. It sits in an altitude of 800 meters above sea level. The continental mediterranean climate of this territory brings plenty of sunlight to the vineyard, and the clay soil retains water, essential for the health of the vines.





## **Tasting notes:**

Bright golden color with lime reflections.

Pear aromas and light tropical notes on the nose. Mouth watering and well structured acidity on the palate.

## **Grape variety**

100% Verdejo. Organic vines planted in 2005.

#### Vinification

By winemaker Ruth Fernández.
Galerna Verdejo is produced with organically grown grapes. It is previously macerated for one day at a temperature of 7°C, then it is raised steadily to 15°C during the fermentation period. Clarified with Bentonite. Physical filtration. Cold stabilization. No animal product used.

Organically Farmed – No chemical pesticides or herbicides used. No GMO Yeast Used. Less than 100ppm Sulfites.
