Galerna is the north-west wind on the north coast of Spain. It usually appears in the spring, portrayed in the blooming flowers on the label. Just like the Galerna winds, the fruity and sweet aromas of this wine can sweep you off your feet!

Background:

Even though it's not native to this country, the Garnacha or Grenache grape enjoys a great popularity in Spain, as it thrives in hot and windy climates such as ours. Anyone who loves fruit and sweet-flavored wines will be delighted with this Galerna.

In the province of Cuenca near central Spain, our vineyard is located in an area where wine culture has been around for decades. It sits in an altitude of 800 meters above sea level. The mediterranean continental climate of this territory brings plenty of sunlight to the vineyard, and the clay soil retains water, essential for the health of the vines.



Tasting notes:

- · COLOR: An intense cherry red color and a violet shaded rim at first sight.
- NOSE: The bouquet has notes of red berries.
- PALATE: Sweet tannins and long finish.

- WINEMAKER: Ruth Fernández.
- · GRAPE: 100% Garnacha, organic vines planted in 2005.
- **BRIX AT HARVEST: 24.3°**
- PH: 3.7
- ACIDITY: 5.7
- **VINIFICATION:** Galerna Garnacha is produced from our Estate-grown grapes, which are organically grown. They are night harvested and cold macerated before the fermentation process begins.
- OAK: Unoaked.
- PAIRING: Cheese and pasta work well with this wine; you can combine it with an eggplant parmesan!
